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*Places of Worship*

ST. MARY'S CHURCH is the most ancient, situated at the top of Church Street; it is a spacious edifice, partly in the decorated style and partly early English. The tower is square, supported by buttresses, ornamented with decorated pinnacles and battlements: there are eight good bells: the walls are very massive. The interior is very beautiful and well fitted with side aisles, galleries, &c. The east and west windows are of a very chaste description, in coloured glass, likewise several of the smaller ones. The Church was reopened after undergoing extensive repairs and decorations in December, 1847, when in the two services £535 was collected towards defraying expenses of the same. On this occasion the choristers wore white gowns, for the first time. A new organ was also obtained June, 1848. There are several ancient monuments. The living is a vicarage in the gift of Lord Ward. The Rev. Thomas Leigh Claughton, M.A., is the present incumbent. Rev. Charles John M. Mottram, M.A., and Hon. and Rev. George Herbert, M.A., curates. Messrs. William Minifie and John Burrows, churchwardens. Mr. Fitzgerald and Mrs. Fletcher, organists. Mr. Thos. Foster, sexton and clerk. Service, 10½ a.m., 3½ p.m., 6½ p.m.; prayers daily, 10 a.m., 7 p.m.

ST. GEORGE'S CHURCH OR CHAPEL OF EASE : delightfully situated at the top of Coventry Street. This is a beautiful building, in the later English style; it has a splendid ornamented tower. This Church was built by a grant from the Parliamentary Commissioners, at an outlay of £16,131, with £2000 added which was raised by public subscription, together with a very good organ, which cost £600. The interior is tastefully fitted with galleries, &c. There are two neat tablets, one in memory of Edmund Yates Peel, Esq., of Waresley, and one to Mrs. Jane Hooman, of Franche. The Rev. Thos. Baker Morrell, M.A., vicar. Rev. Edward Newcombe and Rev. Benjamin Gibbons, curates. Mr. Josiah Allen, clerk. Service, 10½ a.m., 6½ p.m.

ST. JOHN'S CHURCH: situated at Blakebrook; is built of dark brick, and the mouldings of Bath stone. It is in the Norman style ; was erected, 1843, at a cost of £4,000, partly by subscription, partly by a bequest of the late J. Woodward, Esq., and by a grant from the Society for Erecting Churches. Rev. Melsop Hill, M.A., is the present incumbent. Service, 10½ a.m., 6½ p.m.

BAPTIST CHAPEL: situate in Union Street; is a small brick building, erected in 1813, and enlarged in 1887. Rev. John Mills, minister. Service, 10½ a.m., 6 p.m.

INDEPENDENT CHAPEL: situated in the Bull Ring; is a stone fronted building, of large dimensions. The interior is fitted up with every regard to the comfort and accommodation of the congregation. It contains a fine organ, and above the gallery occupied by the congregation, is another set apart for the use of the Sunday Schools belonging to the place, constructed of iron work of a light and elegant design, from the centre of which gallery the Chapel is seen to much advantage, and has a most imposing effect; in the vestry is a fine oil painting of the Rev. Richard Baxter, presented by W. B. Best, Esq. Rev. Albert Creek, minister. Service, 10½ a.m., 6 p.m., Monday and Wednesday, 7 p.m.

LADY HUNTINGDON'S CHAPEL: a small brick building; situate in Dudley Street. Rev. John Carpenter, minister, Service, 10½ a.m., 6 p.m.; Monday and Thursday, 7 p.m.

PRIMITIVE METHODIST CHAPEL : a small neat brick erection, in Cross Street; built in 1832. Rev. Richard Ward, minister. Service, 10½ a.m., 6 p.m.

ROMAN CATHOLIC CHAPEL: situated in Leswell Field. Rev. Peter Holland, priest. Service, 10½ a.m., 6½ p.m.; daily, 8 a.m.

UNITARIAN CHAPEL: situated in Church Street; is a neat building. Rev. Matthew Gibson, minister. Service, 11 a.m., 6¼ p.m.

WESLEYAN METHODIST CHAPEL Mill Street: is a commodious building, with stone front; built 1803, enlarged 1821. Supplied by circuit preachers. Service, 10½ a.m., 6 p.m.

WESLEYAN METHODIST CHAPEL: situated at Lark Hill; is a small brick building, erected 1847. Supplied by circuit preachers. Service, 10½ a.m., 6 p.m.

THE CEMETERY: situated in Park Street; was laid out by public subscription, and open to all denominations. It is under the management of a company of directors, who meet quarterly. Henry Talbot, Esq., treasurer. Mr. James Condie, secretary.

### *Schools*

FREE GRAMMAR SCHOOL: is a handsome building, situated near St. John's Church, was erected in 1848 on its present site. This School was supposed to be founded by Charles I., and was formerly held adjoining St. Mary's Church. The present number of scholars about 35. Rev. Wm. Cockin, M.A., head master; Rev. Edward Brine, B.A., second master; Mr. H. Campbell, assistant master.

DIOCESAN SCHOOL: situated at the top of Coventry Street, in connection with the Worcester Diocesan Board of Education average number of scholars, 50. Rev. Thomas Baker Morrell, M.A., principal; Mr. Richard Johnson, head master; Mr. W. Wm. Taylor, second master.

BRITISH SCHOOLS: in Orchard Street; are large and well arranged rooms, capable of containing a large number of children. The daily average of boys about 110; girls, 110. Richard McDonald, master; Elizabeth Kiteley, governess.

NATIONAL SCHOOLS: situated at the back of St. Mary's Church, in connection with the latter, are well arranged and convenient buildings. The girls' school was built in 1730, and rebuilt 1789; the boys' built in 1817. William David, master; Mary Ann Grimley, mistress. Average daily number of boys, 170 ; girls, 90.

NATIONAL SCHOOLS, in Bewdley Street: was founded by the late John Woodward, Esq., in 1835, and are now attached to St. John's Church. They are supported partly by the interest arising from the sum of £500 invested by the above John Woodward, Esq., by voluntary contributions, and by childrens' pence; they are capable of containing 200 scholars each. The daily average of boys, 106; of girls, 80. Henry Tovey, master; Mary Preece, mistress.

ST. GEORGE'S NATIONAL SUNDAY AND DAY SCHOOLS, George Street; for boys and girls, erected in 1827. James Simpson, master; Louisa Williams, mistress.

ST. MARY'S INFANT SCHOOL: a neat brick building, situated in Cussfield Lane; erected in 1850, in connection with St. Mary's Church, Supported by subscription. Average number of scholars, 150. Elizabeth Anne White, mistress; Emma Rautley, and Frances Davis, Government pupil teachers.

THE PARENT INFANT SCHOOL: Love Lane; erected in 1825. Elizabeth Tuck mistress; Fanny Atkins, assistant.

THE RACKETT SCHOOL is held at a private house in Cussfield Lane, and supported by subscriptions. Average number of scholars, 50. Eliza Edwards, mistress.

THE ROMAN CATHOLIC SCHOOL is held at a private house, at the corner of Coventry Street. Pheonix Campbell, master.

*Public Offices &c.*

TOWN HALL AND BOROUGH POLICE STATION: High Street; contains a room well fitted up for the accommodation of Magistrates to hold meetings. William Merrifield, superintendent and town crier; John Peters, inspector of police.

BOROUGH POLICE STATION: Broadwaters. Thomas Baker, officer.

COUNTY COURT: held at the Town Hall once a month. Benjamin Parham, Esq., judge; Wm. Talbot, Esq., clerk; Mr. Wm. Ackroyd, high bailiff; Mr. Ebenezer Guest, bailiff and broker.

INLAND REVENUE OFFICE: Bell Inn, Coventry Street. Mr. Joshua Shacklock, collector; Mr. Matthew Puckey, supervisor; Henry Hopkins, collector's clerk; John Robert Crawhurst, John Pomerey, and John Wier, officers.

STAMP OFFICE: High Street. Mr. Thomas Mark, sub-distributor.

GAS WORKS: situated in the Sling. Mr. Henry Everist, manager.

THE INFIRMARY: situated at the back of St. Mary's Church, lately erected; is a large and commodious building, connected with which is a Dispensary. Mrs. Miriam James, matron; Mr. William Cowan, house surgeon and secretary.

UNION WORKHOUSE: situate at Blakebrook; is a very commodious brick building. Abraham Turner, Esq., chairman; Henry Brinton, Esq., vice chairman; Mr. Edward Palmer Ryan, master; Mrs. Margaret Ryan, matron; Rev. Thomas Powell, chaplain; Wm. Saunders, Esq., clerk; Mr. Thos. Thursfield, surgeon; Messrs. Robt. Wilkinson and — Mitchell, relieving officers; Edward Perry, schoolmaster; Mary Ann Burman, schoolmistress; John Price, porter.
